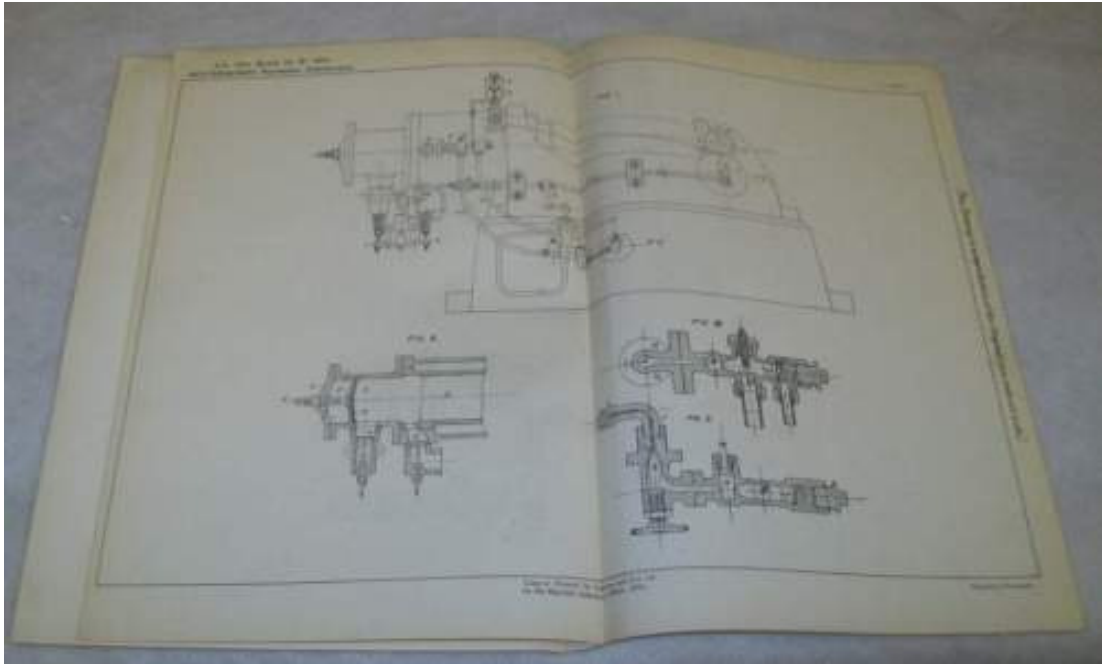

Brief Description of Patent: This invention relates to an improvement in hydrocarbon engines, in which a combustible mixture is produced by mixing hydrocarbon with atmospheric air, under pressure. The engines are constructed on the Otto cycle type, and can be made horizontal or vertical, or portable.
